**FOUNDATION AWARDS \$556,430 IN GRANTS**

**Canton, Ohio** (May 31, 2012) The Board of Directors of the Sisters of Charity Foundation of Canton has announced \$556,430 in grants for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.

**Grants Awarded**

- Alliance Area Habitat for Humanity, \$22,500 support for 1/3 of a house
- Arlington Avenue Church of God, \$3,500 over two years to support *Book Bags of Blessings*
- Association for Better Community Development, \$10,000 to support the Green-Tech Job Training Center
- Boys & Girls Club of Massillon, Inc., \$35,000 to support the KidStop 2012 Summer Program
- Canton City Health Department, up to \$75,000 support for the Stark Public Health Study Commission
- Community Building Partnership of Stark County, Inc., \$20,000 for general operating support
- Faith House Program, Inc., \$6,000 to support transitional housing program
- Hammer & Nails, \$65,000 over two years for general operating support
- Liberty Center Connects, Inc., \$12,430 to support the coalition coordinator for the Rittman and Chippewa coalitions
